#### <u>UNFINISHED BUSINESS</u>

**IWMS Annual Report:** Scheele reported on 2024 UNL TAPS, UNL On-Farm Research Nitrogen & Pivot Bio. He has assisted many producers with programs this past year to improve their irrigation efficiency

### Nitrogen Education plot

Nott presented findings from the Grimes Nitrogen demonstration plot in Kearney County. The data was consistent with a narrow margin of variability. Pivot Bio did not seem to affect the bushels produced. The best net revenue was for the plots with 120 and 160#s of nitrogen following beans.

WCIP Commingled Contract Length: Executive Committee recommended considering a 10-year contract option. There was discussion about whether to allow enrollment of commingled fields West of 183. The Executive Committee will review the commingled WCIP ranking process at their next meeting.

Motion by Bergstrom, seconded by Larson for all new WCIP applicants to have a five or 10 year option for their contracts, Motion carried.

**CNPPID Report:** Dicke reported Excess flows. Started as trickle went from 20 cfs to 500 cfs CNPPID was able to deliver 9-10K af to Elwood, E65, Phelps, Victor Lakes, Cottonwood Ranch. Excess flows are no longer available because the hydrologic condition for the Platte Basin has changed from dry to normal. 7-8 ft in Elwood with still about 14 feet to go.
